Why should we give charity?

1. To become the beloved of Allah

We were created to worship Allah (SWT) and to do everything possible to earn His love. Giving to those less fortunate is an easy way to do that. Although one of the benefits of charity is being able to help others, Islam teaches us that the giver benefits the most.

“Never will you attain the good [reward] until you spend [in the way of Allah] from that which you love...” (3:92)

When you give to charity, you're not just giving to other people: you're giving to Allah (swt). You're taking the provision that He gave you and giving it back to Him in hope that He will gift you the ultimate gift: His everlasting Mercy.

“The believer’s shade on the Day of Resurrection will be his charity.” (Al-Tirmidhi)

On the day when all other shade will be gone, Allah will provide His shade for those who give charity and care for the poor. The Muslim's sacrifice in this life will be their protection on the Day of Judgment.

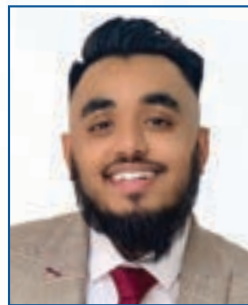

The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organisation estimated that nearly 9million people worldwide I. E. 1 in every 10 person is suffering from malnutrition. Among those children are the most visible victims of under nutrition.

MKC has provided food distribution to many families, mainly widows, women with young children and handicapped and disabled people.



WINTER CLOTHING DISTRIBUTION

Though known for its tropical warm climate, year on year Bangladesh has been experiencing waves of extreme cold. Temperatures have been recorded as low as 4.5 °C and naturally a lot of people, especially the poor, are inadequately prepared for such conditions. Alhamdulillah one of our projects in recent times has been the distribution of winter clothing and blankets to those who need it the most.



HEALTH

MKC foundation is working hard to improve the health system in our areas of work responsible, especially in the rural areas. We are also setting up medical camps and eye clinics for those who cannot afford and suffer in silence.

Our Services are free medicine, dialysis, and cardiology treatment.

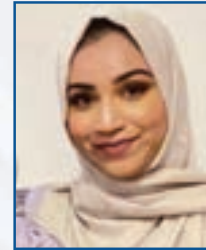

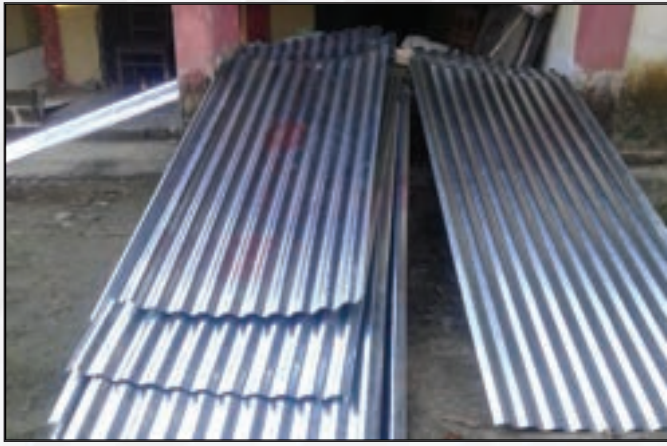

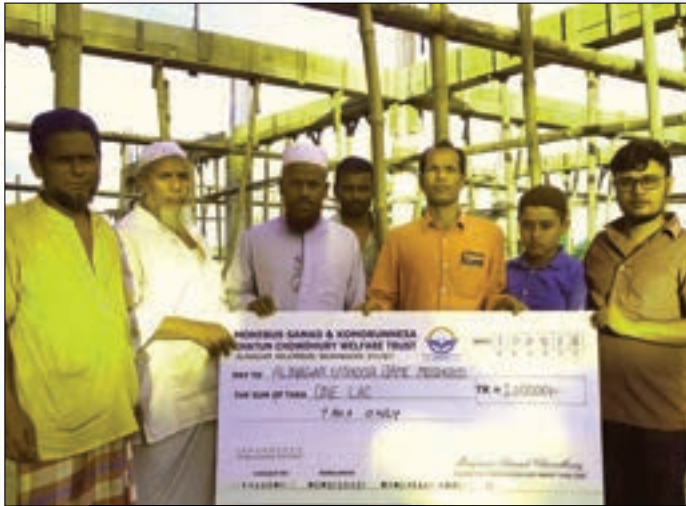
Drainage system
